1. What one thing will you remember most about the Charism Course?

That everyone has charisms. The presentation of the entire course. I'm sure the follow up meeting are going to be very helpful along the journey. Listening to Renee such a sweet calming voice and quiet reflection time studying my charism. I offered to help a friend clean her basement after 2 floods. She was reluctant to let me help.
